Year 10	Post 16 Options and Pathways	Independent Careers Advisor to introduce students to post 16 options and future careers paths including A levels, BTEC, Apprenticeships, High level Apprenticeships, Traineeships, Degrees.
	1-2-1 Careers interviews	30 min Interview with Independent Careers Advisor Individual report to student & parents/carers
	Work Experience	Students are responsible for finding and securing their own work experience placement, which will take place after Easter holidays
	Record of Achievement	Each student produces a Record of Achievement containing a front page, a work experience statement, a personal statement and a C.V.
	Bradford Business Day	Run by local charity SATRO. In small groups, the students create a company, create a product and manage their finances whilst trying to make a profit in a fictional business scenario.
	Godalming fair	Hosted by Godalming College The event is intended to engage and support students to promote progression into further and higher education and employment.
